



## Support low-income Arizona youth and get a credit on your Arizona state tax!

**You can contribute to Science for All, public and private schools, foster care organizations and the AZ Military Relief Fund and reduce your AZ state tax!**

The state of Arizona allows residents to claim each of the following tax credits for 2017-18:

### CONTRIBUTE BY 4/15/18:

	MARRIED	SINGLES
<b>Science for All (Qualifying Charitable Organization)</b>	<b>\$800</b>	<b>\$400</b>
Public School Tax Credit	\$400	\$200
Private School Tuition Credit	\$2,173	\$1,087
Qualifying Foster Care Organization	\$1,000	\$500

### CONTRIBUTE BY 12/31/17:

Arizona Military Relief Fund	\$400	\$200
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\*The Arizona Military Relief Fund has a \$1M cap for tax-credit qualified donations. We therefore recommend you check with them before making your contribution to confirm your donation will qualify for the tax credit.

<b>Total Annual Allowed Tax Credit Contribution</b>	<b>\$4,773</b>	<b>\$2,387</b>
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Residents filing a joint return can therefore claim a total of \$4,773 and single filers a total of \$2,387. Note that residents cannot claim credits in excess of the state tax they owe.

\*If the tax filing deadline is extended, the tax credit donation deadline may also be extended.

**The Arizona Tax Credit for Qualifying Charitable Organizations has doubled! Get up to \$800 in dollar-for-dollar Arizona Tax Credit when you donate to Science for All. Remember you do not need to itemize to take the credit.**

### THE TAX CREDIT What is the Tax Credit for Qualifying Charitable Organizations?

This tax credit is available only for donations to qualified charities that provide services to working-poor families and was previously known as the Working-Poor Tax Credit. Amounts lower than \$400 or \$800 also qualify, so a \$200 gift qualifies you for a \$200 tax credit on your state taxes, lowering your final amount owed.

Science for All provides disadvantaged youth with employer-education partnerships where they gain first-hand knowledge and workforce experience that would normally be out of reach for these students.

Your gift qualifies for a dollar-for-dollar income tax credit up to \$400 (for singles) and up to \$800 (for married couples) and will provide Arizona Grades 6-12 youth living in poverty with critical workplace employability and technical skills necessary for securing 21<sup>st</sup> century employment skills in STEM. We currently serve 69 Arizona schools with low-income student populations. There are over 1300 such schools in Arizona, representing a large unmet need.
